
Ajou GSIS offers various scholarship benefits to students based on their academic performances. Approximately 90% of all enrolled students receive institutional scholarships every semester.



Master of Arts in NGO Studies

Dramatic changes have occurred in global politics due to global civil movements, and the key players in global civil society are Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs). NGOs deal with development issues, the aftermath of global financial crises, information technology revolutions, climate change, and questions related to democracy and human rights at local, national, and global levels. NGOs are at the forefront of multidisciplinary academic debates, such as discussions on the role of government and international organizations in a world of very complex and interconnected political issues. NGOs and Non-Profit Sectors also reach beyond domestic boundaries into the realm of global governance.

In the NGO studies program, students learn about the relationships between academic debates and the everyday practices and policies of NGOs and civil society. The NGO Studies program seeks to develop strong domestic and international networks that combine theory and practice. To achieve these goals, the NGO studies program provides students with a wide variety of subjects, ranging from managerial skills for NGOs to cooperation between NGOs and international organizations.

Master of Arts in International Development Cooperation

The International Development and Cooperation (IDC) degree program combines the study of economic and political development internationally, institutionally, and bilaterally to give students a broad overview of the field. The curriculum is multidisciplinary in its approach and is designed to familiarize students with the basic theories of economic development, overseas development assistance, international political economy, international institutionalism, and environmentally sustainable development practices.

The program provides students with the tools needed to develop as effective practitioners of international development and assistance programs within government agencies, Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs), Non-Profit Organizations (NPOs), and international development agencies. IDC courses incorporate the dominant viewpoints of developed, developing, and underdeveloped countries worldwide. The program aims to help students acquire a well-rounded view of developmental strategies that affect policies and the implementation and effectiveness of IDC practices.

## Department of Energy Studies

Master of Energy Science and Policy

Energy has arisen as an important issue in international society. The global demand for energy resources is increasing; however, energy resources are not easily accessible due to environmental pollution and limited natural resources. These energy problems are largely addressed in the form of policy decisions, technical analyses of innovations, and demonstrations and market expansions in the fields of renewable energy, fossil energy, and nuclear energy. Given the critical importance of energy issues, well-trained and educated experts with multi-disciplinary knowledge of the energy sector are urgently needed both domestically and internationally. The world's energy problems are complex in nature and are closely related to various social, political, economical, industrial, and environmental issues. Furthermore, understanding energy is directly related to the basic sciences and various engineering disciplines. Therefore, energy experts must possess an understanding of social sciences, basic sciences, and engineering and be able to use their knowledge of these disciplines to create balanced solutions to the world's energy crises.

The Department of Energy Studies [Energy Science and Policy] in the Graduate School of International Studies at Ajou University, through this master's degree program, aims to foster the type of advanced workforce needed to address the world's energy issues. The energy experts fostered through this program will have the skills needed to propose and prioritize policies based on their interpretation of the field of energy technology, as well as their understanding of how engineering, society, and science relate to energy systems as a whole. Graduates of this program will become cornerstones in the development of energy policies in each of their respective countries and will serve important roles in cooperative efforts to address the world's ever-increasing energy issues.



## Gazette

The *Gazette* is a student-run news magazine published every semester by students of the Ajou Graduate School of International Studies (GSIS). ## International Symposium and Special Lectures

The Ajou GSIS International Symposium, held annually, provides the bright minds of today, from diverse backgrounds, with an opportunity to present and exchange ideas about current issues. The Symposium not only facilitates the sharing of ideas, but also provides unique opportunities for open discussions. ## Industrial Site Visits

# Campus Housing

On-campus housing provides students with a safe and supportive living environment that is in close proximity to various campus facilities. There are five dormitory buildings that can accommodate a total of about 3,000 students. Each dormitory room is fully furnished with a bed-frame, mattress, desk and chair, dresser, and closet. Our on-campus facilities include a shared kitchen, private and shared bathrooms, a gym, computer rooms, study rooms, TV lounges, and unmanned mailboxes. Fast and reliable 5G wireless internet services are available with wide coverage throughout the campus. The dormitory office also holds seasonal events for the students' entertainment. ## Library

The Ajou Central Library, established in 1973, has achieved remarkable growth over the past 46 years and now (as of 2019) boasts over 1,030,000 books, 30,000 e-resources, over 160,000 theses, 35,000 multimedia materials, and 2,367 seats.

Along with the Library of Medicine and the Law School Library, the Ajou Central Library plays an important role as one of the university's central research facilities. As an academic facility established to achieve the educational goals of Ajou University, the library contributes to the learning, cultural knowledge, and research of university students and faculty members through the collection, accumulation, and distribution of information.


