



# Ajou International Day Events –Food Festival

## Food Festival Pre-Preparation

- ▶ Food Preparation fee :100,000KRW
  - \* Purchase only ingredients for food
- ▶ Every booth has 2~3 Korean volunteers
- ▶ We will Provide:
  - 3m\*3m booth
  - 1 table clothes & 1 table
  - 4 chairs per booth
  - booth name tag and flag
  - T-shirts & Name tag
  - Small disposable containers for free trial
  - Water supply facility, Electricity

# Ajou International Day Events –Food Festival

## Food Preparation

### ▶ Food Preparation Place

- Dormitory Kitchen (Hwahong hall)
- Private place of Korean Booth helpers
- KOICA kitchen for KOICA language students

### ▶ How to use Dormitory Kitchen

- Time: (4pm Nov.5 ~ 10pm/Nov. 6 8am ~ 10am)
- Only Residences can use the kitchen
- Floor : 3F~5F(All residences)
- 2F(Only female students are allowed to cook)
- Not entering burners from outside!! (Very important)

# Ajou International Day Events – Food Festival

## **Please note!!**

- ▶ Food should last for 3–4 hours.
  - The booth will be constructed one day before the festival
  - From 9am, you can start to prepare the food festival
  - Use individual burners of Korean helpers
  
- ▶ How to do the receipt account
  - Gather all receipts from grocery shopping
  - Informal receipt (handwritten receipt) should not be more than 30,000 won!!!!
  - Get the receipt account form from GSIS.
  - Glue the all receipts & fill out the form.
  - Korean Booth leaders should submit the form to GSIS by Nov. 10th (Mon).

# Ajou International Day Events –Food Festival

## ▶ Cooking Utensils

- Pots, burners and other cooking utensils will be provided from Korean volunteers
- Small disposable containers
- Cup 100 ea(2 types: big 50,small 50) per booth
- Dishes(20cms) 50ea per booth
- Chopsticks 50ea / Forks 50ea per booth

## ▶ Preferred food

- Simple but popular food / can be cooked easily
